

Program & Cross Service Area Strategies/Activities to Support Goal : Identification of some key leverage areas of focus that can be measured; theory of action is that focusing on these will impact SR outcomes. For each of the Strategies, there are 2 overarching frames that must be visible and implemented within each area of focus and within the various activities: 1) Lead with Racial Equity and 2) Diverse Learners and their needs (DLL, SpEd/Disabilities, CSHCN, MH)
