**\*Pre-Meeting Action Item:**

1. Site-/Center-level school readiness goals were due by the end of January. Please bring them with you to the CD meeting so you can consider them in light of the data below.
2. We will look at Winter TS GOLD data during the PLC. To prepare, please:
  - a. Look at domain-level reports from **Fall and Winter** for each of your sites for all domains/all children and identify:
    - i. Where there has been the most progress in the % of children below expectations (i.e. **biggest decrease** in this percentage from Fall to Winter)

- ii. Where there has been the least progress in reducing the % of children below expectations (i.e. **smallest decrease** in this percentage from Fall to Winter)
- b. Bring objective-level reports for the domain where there has been the most **or** least progress in the % of children below expectations – depending on if you want to focus in on an area of improvement, or an area of ongoing need.
- c. For the selected objective-level reports, bring reports for each site for:
  - i. All children
  - ii. Hispanic children
  - iii. Children with unspecified ethnicity
