

2015 Washington P-3 Executive Leadership Institute Overview

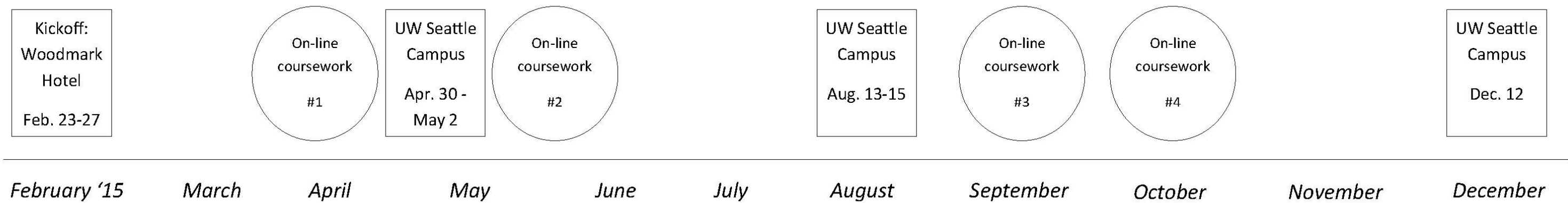
