#### Re-Negotiation – Kay

- In process with HS/EHS 412 grant – put in application for change in scope, relinquish some HS slots
- Changes to begin in September
- Possibilities:
  - Bus monitors for first 6-8 weeks of year
  - Classroom improvements
  - Technology
  - Temporary classroom assistance
  - Pre-service training in beginning of program year
  - Professional Development
  - USDA increases
  - Vision screeners and OAEs

- OAEs and Audiometers have been calibrated and are available today to go back with you.

**Self-Monitoring** – *Safe Arrival/Departure/Transportation* – Talena and Cheryl Polasek

- Directors will work at their tables to fill out matrix for their center
- This is still applicable if you do not transport children and need to participate
- New ECEAP performance standards
- Newish HS performance standards
- This is an assessment to find out what you are doing around transportation

- After you fill out self-assessment matrix, leave it on the tables
- Safe Arrival Departure Agreement used during this activity is the new version that we will be using this coming year
- Talena walked CDs through the Self-Assessment matrix
- If parents self-transport they must follow Washington Restraint law

### **Ready Rosie** – Natalia

- Parenting curriculum
- Interactive family workshops
- Family Home learning video practice
- Ongoing professional development
- Deepens the learning experience
- Builds capacity
- Inspires an ongoing commitment to family learning
- Videos will be sent out to families or have access for families to watch on their own
- Timeline
  - Parent and staff workgroup created
  - Used racial equity lens
  - Presenting to PC next week for approval
  - Train FSS and teachers – working with Ready Rosie, maybe Oct or Nov
  - Ready Rosie will input the parent information for access to site
  - We will be requesting site staff to join a workgroup next program year
- HS/EHS (not HB EHS) is required to use, ECEAP has the option to use as does EHS-HB
- No cost to families
- Enrolled for lifetime
- An app is being created for android and Apple phones
- Available on You Tube, but not on Netflix
- Multi-generational
- Available in English and Spanish as of now, will soon have more languages available
- 4 levels of engagement for sites (see PowerPoint for info)
- Possibility of using Peer Program parents to come to sites/centers

### **Mobility Mentoring** – Natalia

- Mandatory for ECEAP parents
- Advance family goals, well-being and self-reliance
- Statewide family strengths and needs
- Success in family engagement
- Focuses in optimizing the family's life in five domains (refer to PPT)
- Family decision-making and goal-setting model that uses an assessment tool and online database with indicators to measure family and program outcome
- Introduction Bridge should be used during orientation for families

- Family Support staff will be getting training on how to use, beginning early October
- Family Support staff were given the introduction at the FS/HN training that happened in May for staff that attended
- Auburn was a pilot site
- Was done from an American cultural standard, may differ from parents cultural standards
- No wrong or right answer – whatever works for each family
- Assessment is done 3 times a year, first one by Nov 30
- We have been working to change the wording on the bridge to be more culturally inclusive
- Can families opt out? We have that question out to DEL.
- Foundational training on all components in October – *dates available soon*
- Motivational interviewing option
- SMART Goals
- Bridge Pillar resources and training

**Professional Learning** – Talena

- We are still working on M&T Calendar
- We are looking at how we provide PL – large group training vs small group trainings, etc
- What is happening throughout the year?
- Gathered information on what CDs would like to see or how trainings/meetings went this program year – what worked, what didn't
