Updates

- Family Curriculum Requirements – Merri McBride & Amanda Kirk-Woodbury
 - HS Parenting Curriculum
 - HS Performance Standards require a family curriculum
 - ESD has looked at several programs and have narrowed it down to Families Moving Forward, DCRC Your Journey Together, Ready Rosie (web based)
 - Has been shown to Policy Council, Center Director meeting and Open House on Oct 20
 - Will get feedback from those 3 groups
 - Will try to align with Early Achievers
 - ECEAP Mobility Mentoring Curriculum
 - Mobility Mentoring will be required 2018-19
 - Training in the spring
 - Families Moving Forward – optional
 - It was piloted and is not moving forward at this time
- ECEAP Expansion RFA & Enrollment – Talena Dixon
 - DEL has a mandate to be fully enrolled within 30 days of first day of class
 - Centers are feeling stressed to get fully enrolled
 - The legislature looked at the unfilled slots and it came to \$1.2

- Legislature then took that money out of the DEL budget for ECEAP
- Oct 20 is the day DEL will look at unfilled slots
- DEL will look at efforts to get to full enrollment – Talena sends to DEL
- Can enroll over-income families with at least 1 risk factor, we are allotted 9% and are currently at 6%
- We have the ability to move unfilled slots to another contractor – let Talena know if you have the capacity to take those slots through the end of the year
- There is an opportunity to get more slots – talk to Talena today or email
- New slots have to do 3 hours – could possibly negotiate with DEL for less
- Expansion RFA for new slots will be available very soon – Talena will be sending email soon
- 5-year Goals – Kay Lancaster (PPT)
 - As an EL program we set 5-year goals using Self-assessment and data
 - Align our 5-year program goals to new HS Performance Standards
 - Utilize feedback/priorities from Self-Assessment Task Force
 - Identify year 1 objectives that are relevant for year 2
 - Identify additional priority areas
 - Develop cross-cutting themes: aligned with interdisciplinary approach
 - Propose year 2 objectives and workgroup membership
- Policy Council Training – Quincy Stone (PPT)
 - Added Nov 8 mini training, 1-3pm
 - RSVP to Quincy Stone with names and how many
- School Readiness Goals - Merri McBride (PPT)
 - New procedure and guidance for both EHS and HS/ECEAP
 - EHS – individual development strategy support
 - HS/ECEAP – ISRG for preschool – 3 goals
 - Can do more than 3, but 3 is required
 - Align with program school readiness goals
- Organizational Design Evaluation – Nathalie Jones, Laura Lynn (hand out, PPT)
 - Role clarity of ESD staff was identified as a need
 - Site support structures need to be clear
 - Evaluation Advisory Group – Oct 27, 9-12 is the first meeting
