Organizational Design – Nelly

- P-5 Teams – new focus on P-5 services
- One team to deliver all services (EHS, HS, ECEAP, EHS CCP)

Federal Review – Talena

- Being reviewed for our large HS/EHS 412 grant and 0007 grant (EHS-CCP)
- Protocols just recently changed and we are working to get up to date on new protocols
- We will keep Center Directors in the loop as we hear from our Review Coordinator

Full Enrollment – Natalia

- HS/EHS – 90% full
- ECEAP – 87% full
 - Some complications with over-income for ECEAP.
 - Received clarification from DCYF this morning – E-Alert will be sent
 - Be sure that you put the ELMS start date into system for all children enrolled

Safe Arrival/Departure – Talena

- Regulation change – release children to authorized adults (age 18 or over)
- Safe Arrival and Departure Policy has changed to reflect adult
- Needed changes to align with Policy
 - Safe Arrival/Departure Form
 - Emergency Consent Form
 - Other changes: Parent/guardian plans, transportation practices
- Policy Change Notification – translated, parents sign
- Policy Change Notification will go out to everyone and all parents will need to sign it.
- We understand that this will be difficult for a lot of our centers/sites
- Kay & Nellie will be at table 10 during Q&A session today and talk about how this could work at your center/sites.
- Survey was sent out yesterday about how many allow for children to be released to someone under the age of 18
 - What about parents who are under the age of 18 – the parents are the child's legal guardian
