MAXIMUM: Subcontractors may elect additional Parent Representatives from unrepresented sites or if there is a site with more than 94 PSESD Early Learning slots, up to the number of Parent Representatives in the "Maximum" column above.

Policy Council Parent Representatives represent the needs and interests of all PSESD Early Learning program models offered at their site. It's important to ensure that all sites have a link to Policy Council, either by having an elected Parent Representative or creating a communication loop between represented and unrepresented sites.
