

Health Monitoring

Shows number and percentage of enrolled children who met the ECEAP goals for medical and dental homes, medical and dental coverage, exams and immunizations at any time during the school year. This report is used for monitoring purposes and may not reflect a child's current status. See the Health Status by Child report to see each child's current status for the purpose of supporting families in maintaining child health.

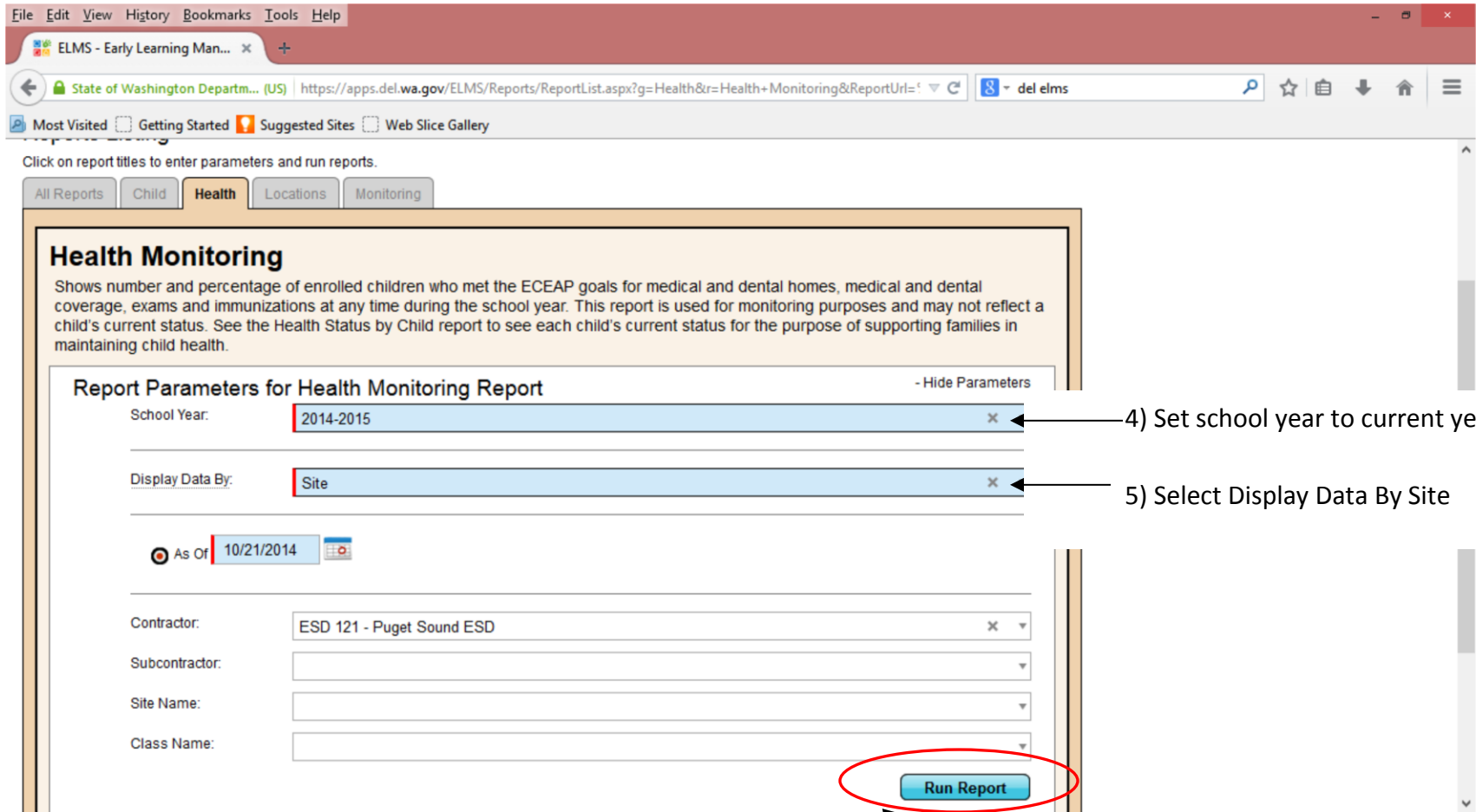
Health Status by Child

Children's names with status of medical and dental homes, medical and dental coverage, exams and immunizations.

2) Click on **Health** tab.

3) Click on **Health Monitoring** Report – this provides information on how complete the overall exams/screenings in a class are. It does not refer to individual children.

(Health Status by child gives you information on each child in a class, but it is not specific as to when actions occurred, rather it is often whether or not an action (exam/screening) occurred or did not occur.)



4) Set school year to current year

Health Monitoring

This report is to monitor ECEAP health services. It has different data than the Health Status by Child report, which shows each child's actual status as of the date of the report. For example, if a well-child exam occurred within 12 months of a child's start in class it is counted as up-to-date on this report, but may not be up-to-date on the Health Status report if more than 12 months have passed since the exam.

Medical home: The child is counted if they had a medical home at enrollment or any time during the school year.
Medical coverage: The child is counted if they had medical coverage at enrollment or any time during the school year.
Well-child exam: The child is counted if they had a medical exam within 12 months prior to their start in class, or any time during the school year. This counts exams that occurred after 90 days in class, as well as exams that are compliant with the ECEAP Performance Standards.
Individual Health Plans: The child is counted if they had an Individual Health Plan at any time during the school year.
Dental Home: The child is counted if they had a dental home at enrollment or any time during the school year.
Dental Coverage: The child is counted if they had dental coverage at enrollment or any time during the school year.
Dental Screenings: The child is counted if they had a dental screening within six months prior to their start in class, or any time during the school year. This counts screenings that occurred after 90 days in class, as well as screenings that are compliant with the ECEAP Performance Standards.
Immunizations: The child is counted if they were up-to-date or exempt from immunizations, at enrollment or any time during the school year.
Enrollment is defined as the date the child was assigned to a class within ELMS.
