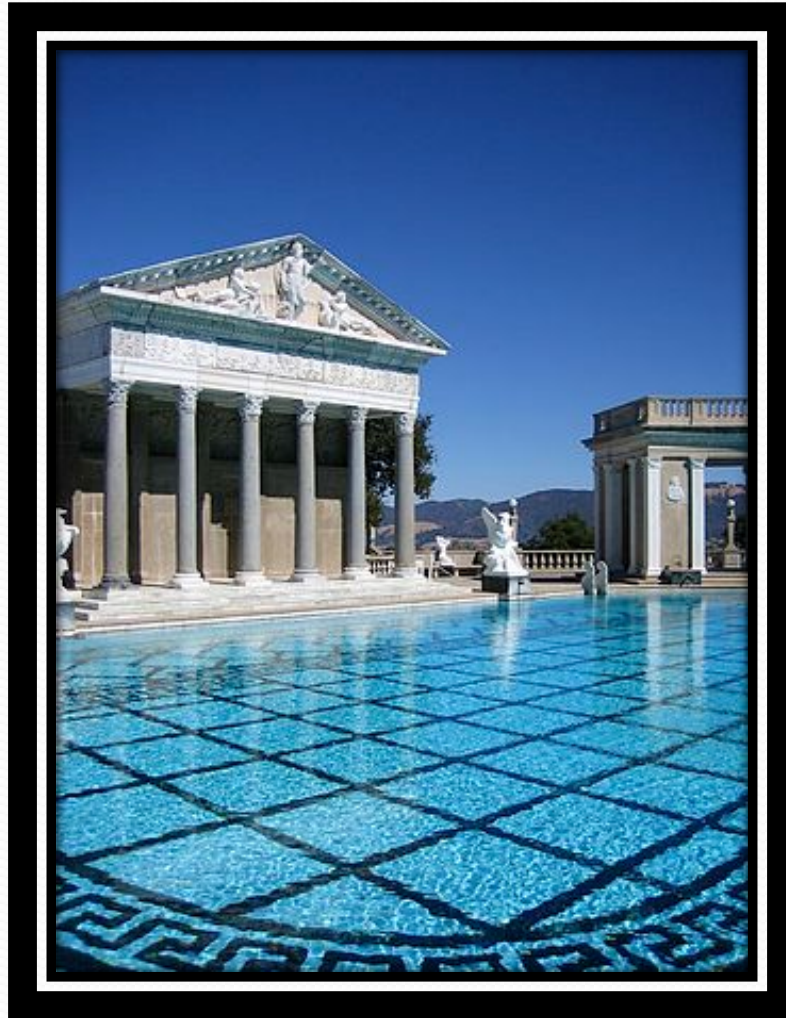


Life of a Social Worker
