Purpose and Procedure

Staff may refer to this list as they have a conversation with the family about the standard definition of Race and Ethnicity and see the definitions of Race below. Explain that this data is gathered so that we can continually improve our practices in closing the Opportunity Gap.

RACE (of the child)

- American Indian or Alaskan Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment.
- Asian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent.
- Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa.
- Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
- White/Caucasian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
- Bi-racial/Multi-racial: A person of two or more races.
- Other: A person reporting a race other than those listed.
- Unspecified: A person whose race is unknown or whose parents declined to identify their race.
