

First Aid Kit Supplies List

This list of supplies must be in the classroom first aid kit. Any additional supplies recommended or restricted by the school district or agency where your site is located will be the responsibility of the school district or agency.

| Item | Purpose |
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| Liquid Soap | Clean wounds |
| Band-Aids of various sizes | Cover minor wounds |
| Compress Bandage | Pressure dressing to stop bleeding |
| Current First Aid Manual | Guide for First Aid steps |
| First Aid Kit Supplies List | Guide for restocking |
| Flashlight with Extra Batteries | Source of light |
| Gauze Squares | Cover wounds, clean wounds |
| Non-latex Gloves | Cover hands before handling blood or other body fluids |
| Goggles | Cover eyes before handling blood or other body fluids |
| Self-Activating Cold Packs | Prevent/reduce swelling |
| Paper Cup | Eye irrigation to remove small foreign object |
| Plastic Bag | Dispose of waste or vomit; used gloves |
| Rolled Gauze | Secure bandage |
| Resusci Face Shield | Rescue Breathing/CPR |
| Scissors | Cut tape, bandages |
| Tape | Secure dressings and bandages |
| Tweezers (disposable) | Remove surface slivers |
| Digital Thermometer with Probe Covers | Measure temperature |
| Triangular Bandage with Safety Pins | Make sling |
| Sealed Bottle of Water | For mixing or cleaning (on field trips) |
| Syrup of Ipecac | Use by direction of Poison Control (Licensed Child Care required) |
| Paper Copies of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Child Health Plan</i> • <i>Medication Administration Record</i> • <i>Health Care Provider's Order for Medications at School</i> • <i>Emergency Treatment and Parent/Guardian Consent</i> • Emergency Contact Phone Numbers | Ensure prompt and correct treatment in emergency situations |
